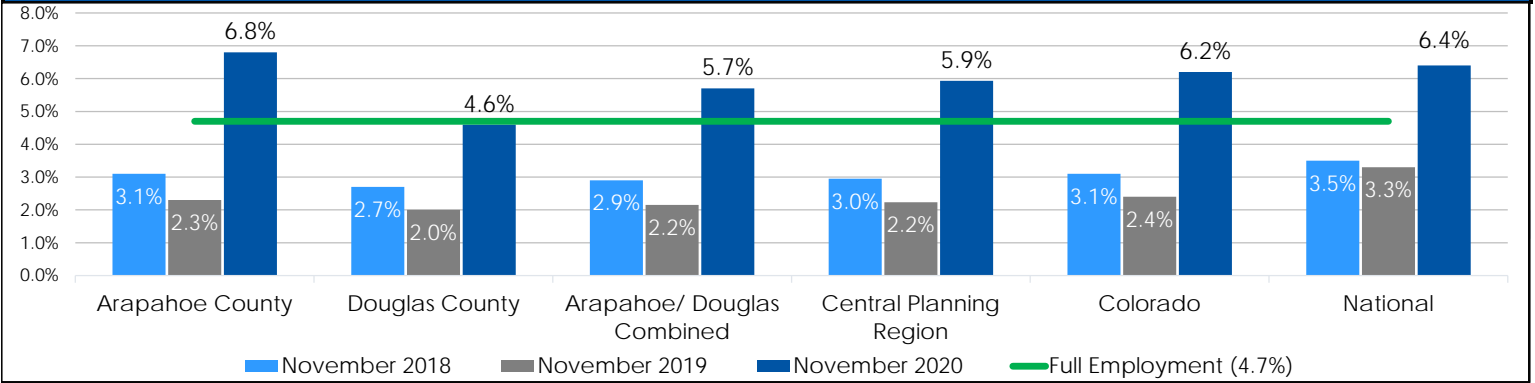

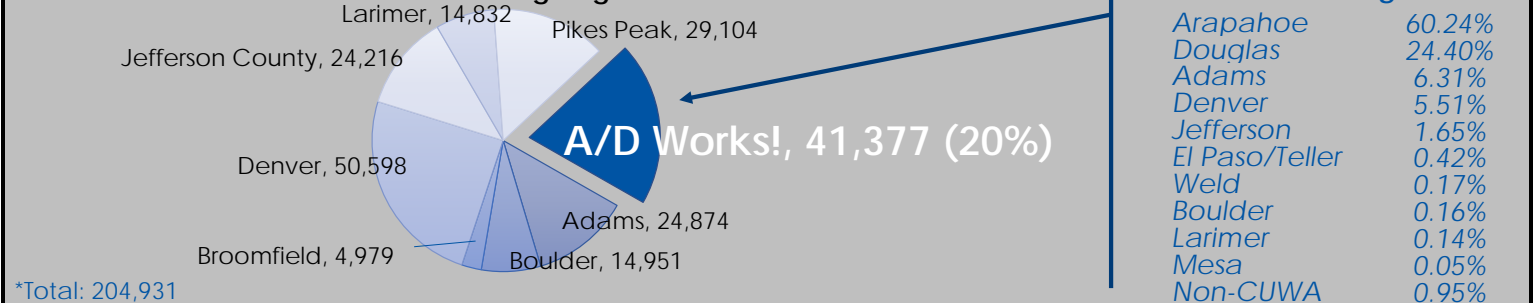

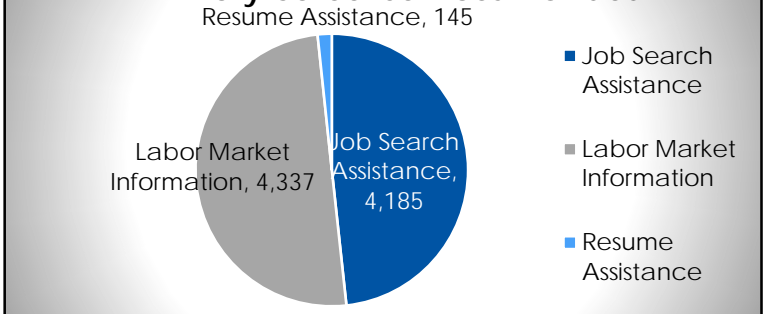
**YTD Self-Reported Customer Demographics**



**Agency Workforce Volume\***

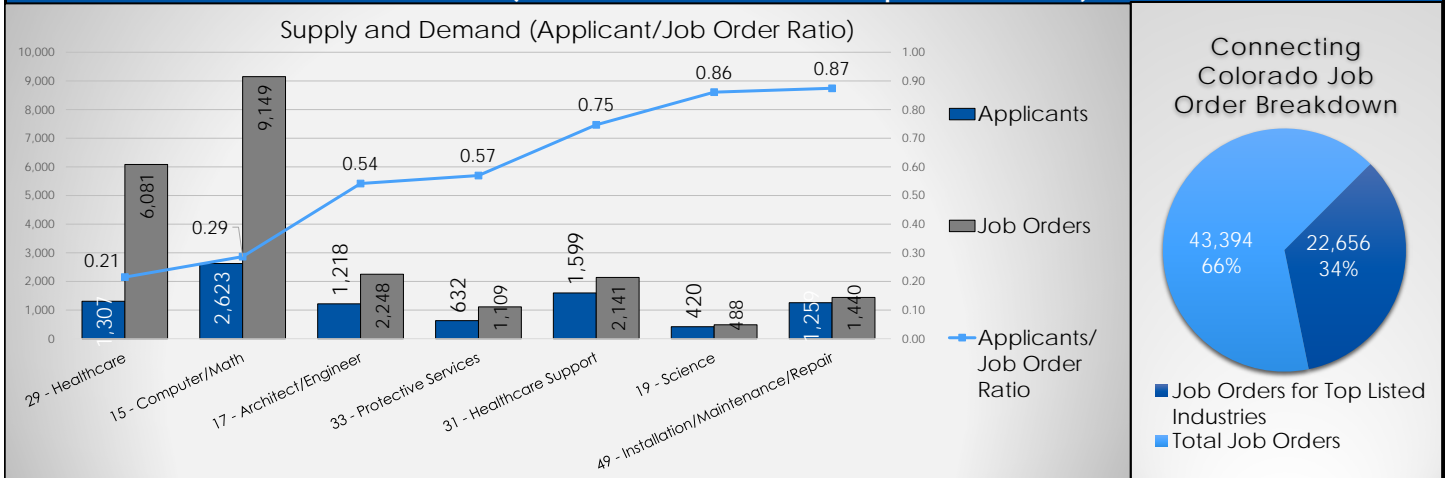


**YTD Primary Career Services Provided**

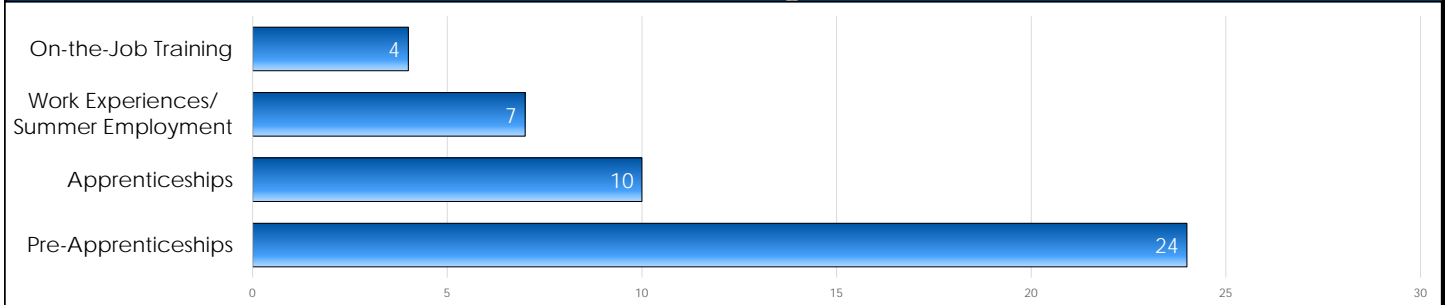
