

Employment Website


Job Boards are search engines that display job openings.

Organizations and recruiters use job boards to post open positions and search resume databases.

Workers use job boards to find new career opportunities and apply for jobs online.

Some job boards utilize applicant tracking systems to help streamline the application process. Job boards can offer employment opportunities across a wide range of sectors, while others are industry specific.

Job Search Engines vs. Job Boards



✓ Job Search Engines

- Usually contain millions of job listings from multiple sources including online job boards.
 Ex: Google, Indeed
- ✓ Job boards may require a job seeker to register to use their website.
 - Many require \$ from employers to post job vacancies or view resumes for open positions.
 - Specialized job boards also may require its users to pay \$ to view openings.

Employer Benefits of Job Boards

- ✓ Job boards are wellknown job advertising tools.
- ✓ Job boards provide resume databases.
- ✓ Job boards help with employer branding.

How to use Job Boards Effectively

- 1. Use the Filter feature
- 2. Look at a range of job boards
- 3. Narrow your search by location
- 4. Use keywords in your search
- 5. Set up alerts for job matches
- 6. Update and upload your resume
- 7. Find the best job board for you



Tips for Applying to a Job Posting

- Understand the process
- Show you have made an effort
- Apply quickly
- Respect the limitations of the software
- Don't shoot yourself in the foot
- Apply directly to the organization whenever possible
